

Arthur B. Hippe – Medication Administration Records (MAR) Summary June 2, 2010 – August 31, 2012: Ajax Pickering Hospital (incomplete draft v.2)

May 29, 2010: Arthur Hippe (AH) was taken to Centenary Hospital Emergency by ambulance showing signs of stroke symptoms, then released the next morning, still exhibiting stroke symptoms.

June 2, 2010: Arthur Hippe was returned by ambulance to Emergency at Ajax Pickering Hospital, because of worsening stroke systems.

NOTE: This record lists only psychiatric/psychotropic (mood-altering) drugs, opioids and other drugs with significant risk of serious side effects such as stroke, heart attack or respiratory arrest or serious behavioural or cognitive side effects. Other drugs have been prescribed and administered to AH but are not listed here.
